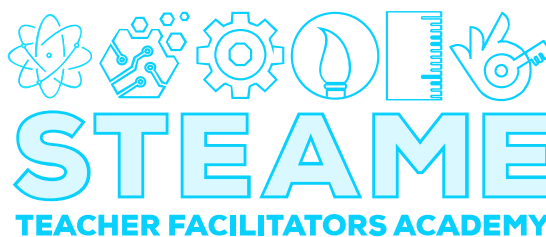

ABOUT



The **STEAME TEACHER FACILITATORS ACADEMY** project is funded by the ERASMUS+ Teacher Academies Programme, with reference number: 101102619. It is coordinated by the University of the National Education Commission, Krakow (UKEN).

The STEAME ACADEMY project aims to establish the Erasmus+ Teacher Academies Network, consisting of 14 diverse organizations from 9 countries, focused on improving teacher education policies and practices in Europe. By creating networks and communities of practice, the project will bring together providers of initial and continuing teacher education, as well as relevant stakeholders, to develop effective and transferable strategies and programs for professional learning. The collaboration will also enhance European and international collaboration in teacher education through innovative partnerships between teacher educators and school teachers, promoting blended training programs and addressing key EU priorities. The project will test models of mobility and establish the European Federation of STEAME Teacher Academies to foster sustainable collaboration and inform teacher education policy makers.

2nd European STEAME-Academy Symposium 12-16 MARCH 2025, THESSALONIKI, GREECE

The European STEAME-ACADEMY Symposium 2025, held from March 12–16 in Thessaloniki, Greece, brought together educators, researchers, and STEAME practitioners from across Europe. The event featured a dynamic program of workshops, research presentations, and interactive sessions focused on project-based learning, AI in education, sustainability, and emerging technologies. Highlights included hands-on activities such as circuit soldering and virtual reality learning, as well as discussions on gender equity in STEAME fields. This collaborative gathering fostered innovation and strengthened the network of STEAME educators committed to shaping the future of education.



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STEAME ACADEMY FREE LIVE WEBINARS

The STEAME Academy consortium has successfully completed its series of the **14 FREE Live Webinars**, related to the Modules developed within the project. The Webinars ran from September 2024 to March 2025.

These webinars were designed to support educators, school leaders, and stakeholders in adopting innovative approaches to STEAME (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Mathematics, and Entrepreneurship) education. The sessions covered a wide range of topics, including project-based learning methodologies, the development and implementation of Learning & Creativity Plans (L&C Plans), interdisciplinary curriculum design, and digital tools for enhanced classroom engagement.

Each webinar served as a platform for knowledge sharing, professional development, and the exchange of best practices across Europe.

Educating the Educators Conference 2025 – 8-9 May 2025, Limassol, Cyprus

The 5th Educating the Educators Conference (ETE 2025) successfully took place in Limassol, Cyprus, bringing together 120 participants from 26 countries. The event offered a dynamic platform for educators, researchers, practitioners, and students in STEM education to exchange ideas, explore new practices, and engage in meaningful dialogue on how education can meet the challenges of today and tomorrow.

It was hosted by the Consortium of the International Centre for STEM Education (ICSE) in partnership with the InSSTER Center at the University of Nicosia, Cyprus, and the ICSE Academy project.

The academic program was structured around four main thematic tracks: Diversity in STEM Education, STEM Education in the Digital Era, Interdisciplinarity in STEM Education, Sustainability, and STEM Education.

Prof. Gregory Makrides presented the STEAME Academy project and participated in a round table discussion.
